Our committee is seeking the following information and documentation concerning the SW Regional Water Reclamation Facility (SWRWR) (FLA-012697). Our WWT Liaison Neal Rehase after attending the SWRWR planning meeting is requesting the following.

- 1. Copy of the "as built" drawings for:
 - Lift Stations OKR-008, OKR-010, OKR-001, OKR-002, OKR-012 and OKR-014
 - Manholes first manhole West of OKR-008 on SW 115th St. Rd.
 - first manhole West of SW 73rd Terrace on SW 115th St. Rd.
 - first manhole East of SW 73rd Terrace on SW 115th St. Rd.
- 2. A list of points where "sniffer" odor tests are being performed in the collection system.
- 3. The concentration in mg/L (ppm) of the Magnesium Hydroxide addition at each injection point in the system.
- 4. The concentration in mg/L (ppm) of Magnesium Hydroxide at the plant.
- 5. Are tests run anywhere else in the collection system to check the concentration of Magnesium Hydroxide? If so where? Please provide written report.
- 6. Is flow data (MIN/MAX/Ave.) recorded for any of the lift stations or manholes in the collection system? If so, what are these values for OKR-008, OKR-010, OKR-012 and OKR014?
- 7. What was the reason for removing air injection from lift stations? Please provide the report for the pilot project.
- 8. Is there any thought of using air injection anywhere in the collection system as a means to contain odor?
- 9. Are there any test results available for gas concentrations (H2S, Methane, etc.) from the collection system?
- 10. Is any regular scheduled testing done to determine gas (H2S, Methane, etc.) concentrations in the collection system?
- 11. Does the utility have a planning mechanism to account for the county's Consolidated Plan?
